

COVID-19 Guidelines Agreement Form
Space Coast Sailing
2020-2021

Effective on the first day of practice, and at every practice, event, or regatta until this organization deems it safe to lift these guidelines, parents and sailors will be required to follow the following set of rules. Persons who fail to follow the rules listed will be removed from the program indefinitely and excluded from all Space Coast Sailing events, practices, and regattas. The following guidelines have been developed by the leadership of Space Coast Sailing in coordination with a Space Coast parent and local physician who has hands-on experience treating COVID-19 patients. By signing this document, you are acknowledging that you have read, understand, and agree to the rules presented and are aware of the consequences if these rules are not followed. A copy of this document must be signed by each sailor and their legal guardian(s) and submitted to the Space Coast Sailing leadership before participating in the program.

- All sailors and parents are required to wear a full-face mask, covering their nose and mouth, when inside any building actively being used for a Space Coast Sailing event, practice, or regatta. This includes but is not limited to the Melbourne Yacht Club and the Eau Gallie Yacht Club, and any buildings on their premises. While rigging or derigging, or during meetings and briefings—including those held outside—sailors and parents are required to wear a full-face mask. Masks are not required to be worn when actively sailing.
- Sailors and parents will be required to stay six feet apart from other sailors, parents, and coaches—with the exception of those persons who they are related to—any time they are at a Space Coast Sailing event, practice, or regatta. The only exception to this rule is 420 sailors, who are permitted to be within six feet of their designated crewmate.
- All sailors and parents attending a Space Coast Sailing event, practice, or regatta will be required to undergo a symptom check upon their arrival to said event, which will include but is not limited to a temperature check, and answering questions regarding their physical state and any potential COVID-19 symptoms, and if they have been exposed to anyone who is carrying the COVID-19 virus.
- All sailors enrolled in the Space Coast Sailing program, and the parents of these sailors, are required to honestly and fully disclose to Space Coast Sailing leadership if they are infected with the COVID-19 virus, and will be required to abstain from participating in Space Coast Sailing events, practices, or regattas for a period of no less than two weeks.
- All sailors and parents attending a Space Coast Sailing event, practice, or regatta are required to fully and honestly disclose any potential incidents of exposure to persons carrying the COVID-19 virus.
- All sailors and parents attending a Space Coast Sailing event, practice, or regatta will be required to sanitize their hands before attending such events. Sanitizer will be provided upon arrival at Space Coast Sailing events, practices, and regattas.
